

# 2025 Impact Report



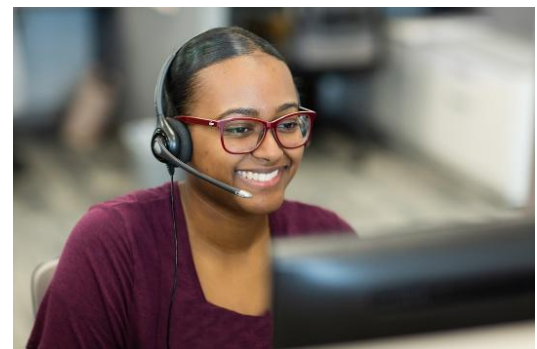
United Way of Logan County mobilizes our community to action so all can thrive!

In 2025, United Way of Logan County distributed **\$74,000 to 14 partner agencies** providing essential services for hundreds of residents. These agencies support youth, seniors, and families through programs like Meals on Wheels for seniors, The Oasis food pantry for low-income seniors, Christian Child Care, and Lincoln Area YMCA for children, as well as new partners in 2025 like Regional Housing and Supportive Services, which operates Hope on 5th for those without housing, and Lincoln Parents' Center, offering in-home education for new parents. A complete list of funded agencies is available in this report.



The United Way of Logan County continues to administer Dolly Parton's Imagination Library to benefit the children of our county. **In 2025 an average of 739 preschoolers** received books each month (up from 724 in 2024). An average of 20 new children joined the library and 14 children graduated from the program (turned age 5) each month. Emersyn (shown here), a local preschooler with a condition that affects her ability to see, also qualified for **Dolly Parton's braille books** and is receiving books through that program. **9,634 free books were sent out to Logan County children in 2025**, and 26,859 books have been sent to local homes through 2025 since the program's inception in 2020.

Logan County residents were able to find local resources when help was needed, thanks to the United Way's sponsorship of 2-1-1 for our community. **260 callers requested help with 311 (up from 182 in 2024) needs in 2025.** 38% of those needs had to do with housing matters, including searches for shelter or help with rent.
